An Act to amend 'The Mineral Lands Act of 1892.'
[Assented to 13th October, 1893.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble

1. This Act may be cited as 'The Mineral Lands Act of 1892, Amendment Act, 1893,' and shall be incorporated with and form part of 'The Mineral Lands Act of 1892.'

Short title and incorporation

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in 'The Mineral Lands Act of 1892,' or the Regulations, the Governor may grant Mineral Leases of any Crown Lands within a mining district, and such leases may comprise such areas and contain such special covenants and privileges, and shall be subject to such rent, fees, conditions, or reservations as the Governor approves or prescribes.

Governor may grant special mineral leases

3. No lease shall be granted as aforesaid unless the general conditions subject to which it is granted have been approved by Parliament.
