AN ACT to provide for the payment of certain Additional and Unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, over and above the Estimates for that year.

[ Assented to, 29th November, 1889. ]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THAT out of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, and not provided for in the Appropriation Act for that year, a sum not exceeding Six Thousand One Hundred and Forty-six Pounds Twelve Shillings and Seven Pence, the said amount being appropriated as set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

Further appropriation of £6,146 12s. 7d. for the year 1889.
