An Act to further amend 'The Boat Licensing Act, 1878.'
[Assented to 26th November, 1888.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend 'The Boat Licensing Act, 1878:' Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. The twenty-first section of 'The Boat Licensing Act, 1878,' shall be read and construed as if after the word 'boats,' wherever mentioned therein, the words 'vessels or steamers' had been inserted, and as if after the word 'boat' the words 'vessel or steamer' had been inserted.

2. The twenty-second and twenty-third sections of the said Act shall be read and construed as if after the word 'boat' therein the words 'vessel or steamer' had been inserted.

3. This Act shall be read and construed together with 'The Boat Licensing Act, 1878,' and also with the Act, passed in the 50th year of Her Majesty the Queen, to amend the same.
