VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. II.

AN ACT to repeal the 50th Victoriæ, No. 21,
being an Act which imposed a Duty upon
Gold.

[Assented to, 22nd July, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western
Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and
consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THAT the 50th Victoriæ, No. 21, be and is hereby
repealed.

Repeal of 50th Vic.,
No. 21.

2. THAT no proceedings be taken for the recovery of any
duty, forfeiture, or penalty imposed by the said Act.

No proceedings to be
taken under repealed
Act.

to this Act.
