AN ACT to provide for the payment to the Colonial Treasurer of Fees received by the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies.

[ Assented to, 20th August, 1887. ]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THAT from and after the first day of September, 1887, all fees in respect of Joint Stock Companies received by the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies, whether under the provisions of "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1858," or otherwise, shall be paid over by him to the Colonial Treasurer as part of the General Revenue of the Colony.

## *The Joint Stock Companies' Fees Act, 1887.*

---

Construction of Sections 12 and 107 of "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1858."

2. THAT the twelfth and one hundred and seventh sections of "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1858," shall be read and construed as if the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies had been therein directed to pay over all such fees to the Colonial Treasurer as part of the General Revenue of the Colony.

Short Title and commencement.

3. THAT this Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Joint Stock Companies' Fees Act, 1887," and shall commence and come into operation on and after the first day of September, 1887.
