An Act for the Re-appropriation of certain moneys appropriated for the purposes of the Extension of the Telegraph System to Kimberley Goldfields, Wyndham, and South Australian Border in the East Kimberley District. *[Assented to 13th August, 1889.]*

WHEREAS by the Re-appropriation Loan Act (50 Vic., No. 23) a sum of Sixty thousand pounds was appropriated for the Extension of the Telegraph System to Kimberley Goldfields, Wyndham, and South Australian Border in the East Kimberley District; And

whereas there remains of the said sum of Sixty thousand pounds an unexpended balance sufficient for the purpose hereinafter mentioned; And whereas it is expedient to appropriate out of the said balance a sum of Six thousand one hundred and eighty-two pounds seven shillings and eight pence for the Telegraph, Roebourne to Derby: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor to appropriate out of the said sum of Sixty thousand pounds in the Schedule to the Re-appropriation Loan Act (50 Vic., No. 23) appropriated to the work Extension of the Telegraph System to Kimberley Goldfields, Wyndham, and South Australian Border in the East Kimberley District, a sum of Six thousand one hundred and eighty-two pounds seven shillings and eight pence for the purpose of completing the construction of the Telegraph, Roebourne to Derby.
