AN ACT to amend "The Roads Act, 1888."

[ Assented to, 30th April, 1889. ]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Roads Act, 1888:"  
Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western  
Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent  
of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as "The Roads Act, 1888, Amend-  
ment Act, 1889."

Short Title.

2. SECTIONS 5 and 9 of the said Act of 1888 are hereby  
amended by omitting the word "Four," in the third and fifth lines  
of the said sections, respectively, and by substituting in lieu thereof  
the word "Three."

Amendment of sec-

3. THIS Act and the said recited Act shall henceforth be read  
together as one Act.
