An Act to amend 'The Supreme Court Act, 1880.'

[Assented to 4th December, 1889.]

Preamble

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend 'The Supreme Court Act, 1880': Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

The Supreme Court Amendment Act, 1889

1. Section nineteen of 'The Supreme Court Act, 1880,' is hereby repealed. Repeal
2. If at any time there shall be more than two Judges of the Supreme Court, and a difference of opinion shall exist amongst such Judges sitting together, the judgment or decision of the majority shall prevail. Opinion of majority of judges to prevail
3. This Act and 'The Supreme Court Act, 1880,' shall be read together as one Act. Incorporation of Supreme Court Act, 1880
4. This Act may be cited as 'The Supreme Court Amendment Act, 1889.' Short title
