An Act to amend 'The Wreck Act, 1887.'

[Assented to 4th December, 1889.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend 'The Wreck Act, 1887':
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of
Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and
consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

The Wreck Act, 1889

Short title

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as 'The Wreck Act, 1889.'

Amendment of
the third section
of 51 Vic., No. 6

2. The third section of 'The Wreck Act, 1887,' shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion of the following proviso after the word 'Colony,' at the end of the tenth line of the said section :—

'Provided also that no investigation shall be held in respect of a casualty (other than a collision with a British ship) happening to a foreign ship belonging to a State which is represented in Western Australia by a Consul, Vice-Consul, or Consular-Agent, except at the request of such representative.'
