AN ACT to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, beyond the grants for that year.

[ Assented to, 13th August, 1883. ]

**W**HEREAS by an Act of the Legislative Council, made and passed in the forty-fifth year of the reign of Her Present Majesty, No. 13 of 1881, the sum of One hundred and fifty-eight thousand nine hundred and eleven pounds four shillings and sevenpence was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two; And whereas by a further Appropriation Act of the said Legislative Council, made and passed in the forty-sixth year of the reign of Her Present Majesty, No. 4 of 1882, the further sum of Eleven thousand six hundred and fifty-eight pounds eleven shillings and tenpence was also granted and applied for the services of the said year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two; And whereas there have been expended for the services of the said year, in excess of the several grants made for the several services, the sums in the

account hereunto annexed, that is to say, in all the sum of Six thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight pounds five shillings and fourpence: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Excess of Expenditure for 1882.

THE sum issued and applied for the services of the year ended the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, beyond the grants obtained for the same year, that is to say, the sum of Six thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight pounds five shillings and fourpence, be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the general Revenues of the Colony.
