AN ACT to provide for the Payment of certain additional and unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, over and above the Estimates for that year.

[Assented to, 15th August, 1883.]

WHEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Revenue of the Colony the several sums hereinafter mentioned to provide for the payment of certain additional and unforeseen expenses for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, over and above the Estimates for the same: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THAT out of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, and not provided for in the Appropriation Act for

that year, a sum not exceeding Twenty-four thousand three hundred and twenty-two pounds nine shillings and fourpence, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:—

<i>Postal and Telegraph Department</i>	Two Thousand and Seven Pounds Ten Shillings.
<i>Medical Department</i>	Three Hundred and Fifty Pounds.
<i>Harbor and Light Department</i> ...	Two Hundred and Sixty Pounds.
<i>Judicial Department</i>	Three Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty-five Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Fourpence.
<i>Police Department</i>	One Thousand and Sixty-nine Pounds.
<i>Gaols Department</i>	Eight Hundred and Thirty-five Pounds.
<i>Rottnest Prison Department</i> ...	One Thousand Five Hundred and Ninety-eight Pounds Nine Shillings and Tenpence.
<i>Inspection of Sheep Department</i> ...	Fifty Pounds.
<i>Poor Relief Department</i>	Seven Hundred and Sixty-nine Pounds.
<i>Colonial Storekeeper's Department</i>	Twenty-five Pounds.
<i>Works and Buildings</i>	Nine Thousand Seven Hundred and Ten Pounds Seventeen Shillings and Sixpence.
<i>Roads and Bridges</i>	Five Hundred and Forty Pounds.
<i>Volunteer Grant</i>	Four Hundred and Forty Pounds.
<i>Literary, Scientific, and Agricultural Grant</i>	Two Hundred and Twenty-five Pounds.
<i>Miscellaneous</i>	Two Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty-four Pounds Three Shillings and Eightpence.
<i>Refunds</i>	One Hundred and Six Pounds Five Shillings.

2. THE Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay such sum or sums of money for the purposes aforesaid, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, as the Governor shall from time to time by warrant under his hand direct.

Treasurer to pay on Governor's Warrant.
