AN ACT to appropriate the sum of Two Hundred and Forty-seven Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-one Pounds Sixteen Shillings and Elevenpence out of the General Revenue of the Colony for such Services as shall come in course of payment during the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.

**W**HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorized to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue the several sums hereinafter mentioned, for such services as shall come in course of payment during the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-five: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. OUT of the General Public Revenue not otherwise by law specially appropriated there shall or may be issued and applied, for such services as shall come in course of payment during the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of Two Hundred and Forty-seven Thousand Four
