AN ACT to amend "The Bills of Sale Act,
1879."

[Assented to, 21st September, 1882.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Bills of Sale Act,
1879:" Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of
Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice
and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THAT the words "residing or," in the sixth line of
sub-section one of section ten of the said Act, are hereby repealed. ^{43 V. 19, s. 10.}
The said Act shall be read as though such words had never been
inserted therein.
