An Act to amend 'The Cattle Trespass, Fencing, and
Impounding Act, 1882.'

[Assented to 13th September, 1884.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend 'The Cattle Trespass, Fencing, and Impounding Act, 1882' (hereinafter called the principal Act): Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Preamble:

Cattle Trespass, Fencing, and Impounding Act—Amendment

Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Repeal of s. 14
of 46 Vic., No. 7
Reservation of
rights of Crown

1. Section 14 of the principal Act shall be and is hereby repealed.

2. Nothing in the principal Act contained shall in any way affect the rights, powers, or privileges given, granted, or reserved to Her Majesty or her subjects in and by any Ordinance, law, or deed.
