AN ACT to amend and make perpetual "The Game Act, 1874."

[Assented to, 7th September, 1876.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend and make perpetual Preamble. "The Game Act, 1874;" Be it therefore enacted by His 38 Vict., No. 4. Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:----

1 THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Game Act, Short Title. 1874, Amendment Act, 1876."

"THE Game Act, 1874" as amended by this Act is hereby 38 Vict., No. 4 as amended made perpetual. made perpetual.

3 THE said Act shall be taken and construed as if the second Second schedule of 38 Vict., schedule thereto was omitted, and the schedule to this Act inserted provisions made in lieu in lieu thereof. thereof.

Game Act-Amendment.

Game, &c., destroyed or taken, to be delivered up.

4 IT shall be lawful for any Justice of the Peace, on the conviction of any person under "The Game Act, 1874," to order any game, whether imported or native, and also any eggs, whether of imported or native game birds, that may have been killed, destroyed, or taken by such person, to be delivered up to such Justice, to be disposed of as to such Justice may seem meet.
