AN ACT to amend "The High School Act,
1876."

[Assented to, 24th July, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The High School Act,
1876"; Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Preamble.
Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as
follows:—

1 IT shall be lawful for any person appointed or elected a
Governor of the High School, by writing under his hand, addressed Resignation of Governors of
High School.
to the Governor, to resign his post of Governor. Any such letter of
resignation shall be laid on the table of the Legislative Council,
if received while the said Council is in session, forthwith; and if
received when the said council is not in session, at the commence-
ment of its next session.

High School Act, 1876—Amendment.

2 ANY Governor of the said school who shall be absent from the Colony for a period of twelve calendar months, shall be deemed at the end of such period to have resigned the post of Governor to all intents and purposes.

Governor absent from Colony for twelve months, shall be deemed to have resigned.

3 WHENEVER any Governor resigns his post pursuant to the above provisions, a casual vacancy shall be deemed to have occurred within the meaning of the said Act of 1876.

Resignation to create casual vacancy.

4 SECTION two of the said Act of 1876 shall be and the same is hereby amended, by striking out the words "as aforesaid," in lines thirty and thirty-one of the same.
