AN ACT to extend the provisions of "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1858," to Insurance Companies.

[Assented to, 13th September, 1884.]

WHEREAS it is desirable that the provisions of "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1858," should be extended to Insurance Companies: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THE words "or insurance," in the second section of the said Ordinance, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
