AN ACT to provide for the more effectual Control of all Monies raised by Loan for Public Works purposes.

[ Reserved, 23rd September, 1882. ]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the more effectual Control by the Legislature of all Monies raised by Loan for Public Works purposes: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Loan Control Act, 1882."

Title.

2. SO much of the monies raised under any Loan Acts now or hereafter to be in force in this Colony as may be required for the salaries and allowances of officers, or the wages of workmen, for the purpose of the said Acts, and also for the construction of the

Loan expenditure for salaries, buildings, &c., to be laid before Legislative Council.

several buildings, and purchase of rolling stock which may be required for the purpose aforesaid, shall be annually submitted to the Legislative Council.

Annual statement and estimate of proposed expenditure to be submitted for sanction of Legislative Council.

3. AN estimate of the expenditure which it is proposed to incur for the before mentioned purposes, during the ensuing twelve months, and also a statement showing the works and purposes for or in respect of which all monies raised by loan have been applied during the preceding year, shall be laid before the Legislative Council as soon as possible after the ordinary annual meeting thereof, and the aforesaid estimate shall be submitted for the sanction of the Legislative Council in the same manner as the annual estimate of expenditure for the public service.
