AN ACT to amend "The Railways Act, 1873."

[Assented to, 17th August, 1877.]

WHEREAS it is by "The Railways Act, 1873," provided that no railway shall be opened for public traffic until the Commissioner of Crown Lands has certified, by notice to that effect in the *Government Gazette*, that such railway may safely be used for public traffic; and whereas it is expedient to make the Director of Public Works or some other officer appointed in that behalf by the Governor the proper person to certify as aforesaid, in lieu of the Commissioner of Crown Lands; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—
