AN ACT to further amend "The Wines, Beer,
and Spirit Sale Act, 1872."

[Assented to, 8th October, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Wines,
Beer, and Spirit Sale Act, 1872": Be it therefore enacted
by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its
Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof, as follows:—

1 THIS Act may be cited as "The Wines, Beer, and Spirit
Sale Act, 1872, Amendment Act, 1879," and this Act and the said
Act of 1872 shall be read and taken together as one Act.

2 SECTION 39 of "The Wines, Beer, and Spirit Sale Act, 1872," is hereby amended by omitting the words "drunken or disorderly persons" in the third and fourth lines of the said section; and by inserting the word "or" in the third line of the said section, between the words "prostitutes" and "thieves."
