AN ACT to amend the Ordinance 5th Victoria, No. 14, of 1841.

[Assented to, 17th July, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinances relating to the annoyance occasioned by Dogs in the Colony of Western Australia; Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 THE words "less than twenty shillings nor," in the first section of the Ordinance 5th Victoria, No. 14, shall be hereby repealed.

Preamble.

Words defining minimum penalty in s. 1 of 5 V. 14, repealed.

2 THE second section of the said Ordinance, 5th Victoria, No. 14, shall be read as if the words "or to the effect" had been inserted therein between the words "form" and "in" lastly occurring in the said section.

Dogs—Amendment.

To whom applications, &c.,
to be made.

3 THE applications, particulars, descriptions, and declarations by the said Ordinance directed to be given to or made before, and every act thereby directed or authorised to be done by, the Collector or Sub-Collector of Revenue of the district, shall be given to or made or done by or before an officer or servant duly appointed in that behalf of the municipality to whom all fees for dog licensing shall from time to time be payable by virtue of "The Municipal Institutions' Act, 1871."
