AN ACT to amend the Land Transfer Duty Act.

[Assented to, 17th July, 1874.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Land Transfer Duty Act; Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

**1** THE eighth section of the said Act of Council, 4th and 5th Victoria, No. 13, shall be read and construed as if the words “nor to any lands sold by public auction” were not contained therein.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
