AN ORDINANCE to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, beyond the grant for that year.

[12th July, 1869.]

WHEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council made Preamble. and passed in the Thirty-first year of the reign of Her present Majesty, No. 13 of 1867, the sum of Ninety-three thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight pounds was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight; and whereas there has been expended for the services of the said year in excess of the grants made for the several services in the account hereunto annexed, the sum of Four thousand six hundred and thirty-one pounds, six shillings, and one penny: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

THE sums issued and applied for the services of the year ended the thirty-first day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, beyond the grant obtained for the same year, that is to say, the Excess of Expenditure for 1868.
