AN ORDINANCE to confirm the Expenditure for the Services of the Year 1862 beyond the Grant for that Year.
[15th July, 1863.]

WHEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council made and passed in the 25th of Vict., "No. 7, of 1861," the sum of Sixty-four Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-six Pounds, Six Shillings and Eight Pence was granted and applied for the Services of the Year One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty-two. And whereas there has been expended for the service of the said year in excess of the Grants made for the several services in the Schedule hereto mentioned the sum of Ten thousand one hundred and seventy-one pounds, eight shillings and nine pence. And whereas there exists a surplus on the Grants made for the several other services in the Schedule also enumerated amounting to the sum of Two thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine pounds; nineteen shillings and one penny; Be it enacted by His Excellency The Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:—

Excess of Expenditure in

I. THAT there shall and may be applied in and towards making good the said excess of Ten thousand one hundred and seventy-one pounds, eight shillings and nine pence, the said sum of Two thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine pounds nineteen shillings and one penny being the aforesaid surplus on the Grants for the said several services; and further that the then residue or balance issued and applied for the services of the said year ended the Thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, beyond the Grant obtained for the same, that is to say, the sum of Seven thousand two hundred and eighty-one pounds, nine shillings and eight pence be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed and is hereby declared to be a charge against the general Revenues of the Colony.
