AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of Seventy Six Thousand and Fifty Nine Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony, for the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

[7th July, 1865.]

WHEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue, the several sums hereinafter mentioned for the service of the year, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six; Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. OUT of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by Law specially appropriated, there shall or may be issued and applied for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of Seventy Six Thousand

and Fifty Nine Pounds, for defraying the charge of the Colonial Government for the year ending the Thirty-first day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely :—

2. The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay such sum or sums of money for the purposes aforesaid, not exceeding in the whole Treasurer to pay on the Governor's Warrant.
