AN ORDINANCE to amend "An Ordinance to make compulsory the Practice of Vaccination."

**W**HEREAS it has been found that the Fees for Vaccination are excessive; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council thereof:

Preamble.

I.

Fee for every successful  
Vaccination 1s.

I. THAT it shall not be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer from Time to Time, or at any Time, to pay any District Vaccinator appointed under and in pursuance of the Ordinance of the Legislative Council 24th Victoria No. 11 of 1860, any Sum exceeding One Shilling for any successful Case of Vaccination returned to the Central Vaccine Board in pursuance of the said Ordinance, anything therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
