An Ordinance to provide for the payment
of certain unforeseen expenses during the
Year 1852.

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen expenses of the present year 1852, for which no provision was made in the Ordinance for that year;—Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the Revenue of the said colony

there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1852, and not provided for in the Ordinance of that year, a sum not exceeding £9,362 5s. 4d., in the manner following; that is to say:—

For the expenditure of the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding two thousand two hundred and sixty-seven pounds, fourteen shillings and seven pence.

For Pensioners' Gratuities, &c., a sum not exceeding fifty pounds.

For Revenue Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding sixty pounds.

For Administration of Justice, a sum not exceeding one hundred and ten pounds.

For Charitable Allowances, a sum not exceeding forty pounds.

For Hospitals, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding two hundred and forty pounds.

For Police and Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding four hundred and thirty pounds.

For Rent, a sum not exceeding ten pounds.

For conveyance of Mails, a sum not exceeding one hundred and ten pounds.

For Works and Buildings, a sum not exceeding three thousand nine hundred and forty-nine pounds.

For Roads, Streets, and Buildings, a sum not exceeding seven hundred and twenty pounds.

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding five hundred pounds.

For Aborigines, a sum not exceeding one hundred and thirty pounds.

For the Harbour Master, a sum not exceeding two hundred and ninety-three pounds.

For Repayment of Debts, a sum not exceeding three hundred and two pounds, ten shillings and nine-pence.

For purchase of Race Course, a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty pounds.

In the manner more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of expenditure respectively in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

II. AND be it further enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and

in such portions, as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, and signed by him, from time to time direct, and the said Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
