An Ordinance to provide for an excess of  
Expenditure in the year 1853, over and  
above the Estimates for the same.

**W**HEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of  
certain unforeseen expenses for the year 1853, over and  
above the Estimates for the same;—Be it therefore enacted, by  
His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Depen-

dencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the Revenue of the said Colony, there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the Supplementary Charge for the Service of the Year ending on the 31st day of December, 1853, and not provided for in the Ordinance for that year, a sum not exceeding £6,016 3s. 9d., in the manner following, that is to say,—

For the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding £353 16s. 6d.

For Revenue Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding 15s. 7d.

For Administration of Justice, £4 7s. 6d.

For Ecclesiastical Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £3 2s.

For Hospitals, £367 14s. 2d.

For Police, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £85 8s. 4d.

For Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £1229 15s. 1d.

For Rent, a sum not exceeding £19.

For Works and Buildings, a sum not exceeding £2000 7s. 7d.

For Roads, Streets, and Bridges, a sum not exceeding £1153 10s.

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding £235 0s. 7d.

For Immigration, a sum not exceeding £108 12s.

For Aborigines, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £8 7s.

For Harbour Master, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £440 12s. 1d.

For Interest, a sum not exceeding £5 5s.

As more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of expenditure respectively, in the schedule hereunto annexed.

II. AND be it enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue, and pay from time to time, any sum or sums of money, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, signed by him, from time to time direct; and the said Treasurer shall in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of such persons to whom such sums

shall have been so paid, shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amounts thereof respectively shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
