**An Ordinance for further Regulating the  
Storage of Gunpowder.**

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the reduction of the Storage Rent of Gunpowder in the Government Magazines below the rate or rates at which the same is now fixed by Law; —Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that so much of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1850 as fixes the storage rent of Gunpowder in

Government Magazines at the rate contained in the Schedule thereunto annexed, shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

II. THAT it shall be lawful for the Governor of the said Colony, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, by proclamation, to appoint and fix, and from time to time to vary the rate of storage Rent (not exceeding nevertheless, the rate contained in the Schedule to the said recited Ordinance annexed) which shall be paid for any such Gunpowder deposited in any Government Magazine appointed under the provisions of the said Ordinance, and such Rent shall accordingly be paid by the Importer or Proprietor of such Gunpowder.

III. THAT all storage rent paid under the provisions hereinbefore contained shall be appropriated to the use of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, for the Public uses of the said Colony and the support of the Government thereof.
