**An Ordinance to explain and amend the
14th Vict., No 14, intituled "An Ordinance
for Licensing Carts and Carriers."**

WHEREAS in the 14th year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, an Ordinance was passed intituled "An Ordinance for Licensing Carts and Carriers," wherein certain expressions occur, the construction of which requires to be explained and enlarged as herein set forth;—Be it therefore enacted, ^{"Agricultural" Produce} by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its ^{to include pastoral and} Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative ^{tillage, and dairy, &c.}

Council thereof, that, from and after the passing of this Ordinance the words "Agricultural Produce" in the said recited Ordinance, shall be deemed and taken to mean and include all produce of pastoral farms, as well as of tillage farms, and fish, game, and dairy produce.
