An Act for applying certain Sums arising from the Revenue receivable in the Colony of Western Australia to the service thereof, for the Financial Year commencing First of April, One thousand eight hundred and forty-four.

WHEREAS power and authority have been vested in the Governor of Western Australia, acting with the advice and con- Preamble.

sent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, to make, ordain, and establish all such Laws and Ordinances as may be necessary for the maintenance of the peace, order, and good government of the same;—Be it therefore enacted, by his Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the produce of the Revenue of the said Colony, there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding Two hundred and eighty-nine Pounds, Three Shillings, and five-pence, for defraying the supplementary charge for the service of the year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, One thousand eight hundred and forty-three, as detailed in the annexed schedules.

II. AND be it enacted, that out of the produce of the Revenue of the said Colony, there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums not exceeding Ten Thousand Three Hundred and Four Pounds, Nineteen Shillings, and Two Pence, for defraying the expenses of those Establishments chargeable on the Colonial Fund for the year commencing First of April, One thousand eight hundred and forty-four, as hereinafter more particularly expressed—that is to say,

III. AND be it enacted, that the Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct, and that the payment so made, shall be charged upon, and payable out of the Revenue of the said Colony.

Treasurer to pay over salaries, &c., as the Governor shall direct.

IV. AND be it enacted, that the said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and that the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid, shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned, and that he shall and do receive credit for the same accordingly.

Receipts of parties to be a sufficient discharge to Treasurer.
