**An Ordinance to renew certain Acts appointing Places for the Landing of Goods within the Limits of Towns not being seaport Towns.**

**W**HEREAS an Act was passed in the seventh year of the reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to appoint certain places for the landing of goods within the limits of towns, not being seaport towns," which said Act was further explained by an Act passed in the eighth year of the reign of Her present Majesty,

7th Vict. No. 5, and 8th Vict. No. 1, renewed and made perpetual.

entitled "an Act to remove doubts as to the liability of certain parties to pay for landing goods under special permission at other places than the appointed landing places; and whereas the said Acts have now expired, and it is expedient to revive the same;—Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that the said Acts shall be and the same are hereby renewed and made perpetual.

Indemnity to parties acting during the interval, and such acts made valid.

II. AND be it further enacted, that all persons who shall have acted according to the provisions of the said Acts during the interval since the expiration of the same shall be, and they are hereby jointly and severally indemnified, freed, and discharged from and against all Actions, Suits, Prosecutions and Penalties whatsoever for or on account of or in respect of any acts done during the said interval in pursuance of, or in conformity with, the provisions of the said Acts, and all such acts done by them as aforesaid are hereby confirmed and made binding.
