AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1899.

[Assented to, 20th December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Fisheries Act Amendment Act, 1902, and shall be read as one with the Fisheries Act, 1899, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Shor titl^e.

2. SECTION two of the principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of Western Australian waters, and by inserting in place thereof:—"The words 'Western Australian waters' include every tidal river, and every estuary or arm of the sea, and the sea to three miles from high water mark, and the waters of every river,

stream, brook, creek, lake, or lagoon which at any time of the year have access to the sea, and notwithstanding that the land covered by the water is private land alienated by the Crown; but any waters may be exempted, by proclamation, from the operation of this Act.”
