AN ACT to further amend the Health Act,
1898.

[Assented to, 20th December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Health Act Amendment Act, 1902, and shall be read as one with the Health Act, 1898, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. SECTION one hundred and seventy-nine of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "advance," in line four, the words "or by equal monthly or other instalments in advance." Amendment of 62 Vict., No. 24, s. 179.
