AN ACT to amend the Local Inscribed Stock Act, 1897.

[Assented to, 11th December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. SECTION six of the Local Inscribed Stock Act, 1897, is hereby amended by striking out the words "ten pounds," in the second line thereof, and inserting the words "five pounds" in lieu thereof.
