AN ACT to enable the purpose of portions of
Permanent Reserves No. 5691 A[^] and No.
5183 A[^] to be changed.

[Assented to, 20th December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. THAT portion of the permanent reserve numbered 5691 A[^],
known as Perth Suburban Lot 437, containing two roods thirty-six
perches, and now dedicated to the purpose of a school site, is
excluded from the said reserve and included in the permanent
reserve numbered 5694[^], and dedicated to the purpose of public
gardens.

2. THAT portion of the permanent reserve numbered 5183 AΛ, known as Perth Suburban Lot 436, containing one acre, is excluded from the said reserve 5183 AΛ and included in reserve 5691 AΛ, and dedicated to the purpose of a school site.
