An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Account —

- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2008 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and the *Treasurer's Advance Authorisation Act 2008*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2009 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and the *Treasurer's Advance Authorisation Act 2009*.**

[Assented to 3 June 2010]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1. Short title

This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Capital 2007-08 and 2008-09 (Supplementary) Act 2010*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows —

- (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

3. Appropriation for capital purposes

- (1) The sum of \$162 334 792.23, being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2008 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and the *Treasurer's Advance Authorisation Act 2008* and charged to the Consolidated Account under the *Financial Management Act 2006*, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
- (2) The sum of \$139 040 659.00, being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2009 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and the *Treasurer's Advance Authorisation Act 2009* and charged to the Consolidated Account under the *Financial Management Act 2006*, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 2.
