Capital 2013-14 Act 2013**

No. 17 of 2013

An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2014.

[Assented to 21 October 2013]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1. Short title

This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Capital 2013-14 Act 2013*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows —

- (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

3. Issue and application of moneys

- (1) The sum of \$1 792 489 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year beginning on 1 July 2013 and ending on 30 June 2014.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Supply Act 2013* and the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Recurrent 2013-14 Act 2013*.

4. Appropriation for capital purposes

The sum of \$2 985 489 000 comprising —

- (a) the sum granted by section 3 as supply; and
- (b) the sum of \$1 193 000 000 referred to in the *Supply Act 2013* section 3(1)(b) and granted by that Act as supply,

is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
