## **By-Law Providing For Enforcement of Any By-Law Made Under Section 30**

**1. Executive officer may commence proceedings**

The executive officer of any Local Authority to which By-laws under Section 30 apply is hereby empowered in his own name to prosecute or to take any necessary legal proceedings to enforce such By-laws.

**2. Responsible officer may commence proceedings**

Where a By-law under the said Section 30 makes any officer or employee of a Local Authority a responsible officer or any other person a responsible officer, such officer, employee, or person is hereby authorised and empowered in his own name to prosecute or to take any necessary legal proceedings to enforce such By-laws.

**3. Application**

This By-law shall have the force of law in the District of every Local Authority in the State of Western Australia.
