## **Dividing Fences Regulations 1971**

### **1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Dividing Fences Regulations 1971*<sup>1</sup>.

### **2. Interpretation**

In these regulations —

*open spaces, public, rights of way, roads, streets*, have the same respective meanings as they have in and for the purposes of the *Town Planning and Development Act 1928*; and

*the Act* means the *Dividing Fences Act 1961*.

### **3. Exclusion from meaning of “owner”**

Under and for the purposes of the Act “owner” does not include —

- (a) any trustees or other persons in whom land is vested; or
- (b) a person who has the care, control and management of land used,

for open spaces, streets, roads, or rights of way that are public.
