## **Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Western Australia) Regulations 1995**

### **1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Western Australia) Regulations 1995*<sup>1</sup>.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Western Australia) Act 1995* comes into operation<sup>1</sup>.

### **3. *Health (Pesticides) Regulations 2011* are eligible law**

The *Health (Pesticides) Regulations 2011* are declared to be an eligible law of this jurisdiction for the purposes referred to in section 33 of the Act.

### **4. Certain enactments have effect despite the Agvet Code and Agvet Regulations of this jurisdiction**

- (1) The *Occupational Health, Safety and Welfare Act 1984* has effect despite the Agvet Code.
