## **Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2014**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

### **1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2014*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day fixed under the *Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008* section 2(b).

### **3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Regulations 2007*.

### **4. Regulation 4 amended**

In regulation 4 delete the definition of *driver licence* and insert:

*driver licence* means an Australian driver licence as defined in the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008* section 3(1);

**5. Regulation 215 amended**

In regulation 215(4)(b) delete “*Road Traffic Act 1974*,” and insert:

*Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008* section 5,

**6. Regulation 230 amended**

(1) Delete regulation 230(1)(c) and insert:

(c) in respect of which the person has been granted a vehicle licence under the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012* Part 2.

(2) In regulation 230(3) delete “licence for the road vehicle granted under the *Road Traffic Act 1974* Part III.” and insert:

vehicle licence granted under the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012* Part 2 for the road vehicle.
