Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Amendment Regulations 2014

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Amendment Regulations 2014*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day fixed under the *Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008* section 2(b).

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Regulations 1964*.

4. Regulation 2 amended

- (1) In regulation 2 delete the definitions of:

axle

GVM

motor carrier

motor cycle

semi-trailer

trailer

- (2) In regulation 2 insert in alphabetical order:

axle has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Regulations 2014* regulation 3;

GVM has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012* section 3(1);

motor carrier has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Regulations 2014* regulation 3;

motor cycle has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Regulations 2014* regulation 3;

semi-trailer has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014* regulation 3;

trailer has the meaning given in the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014* regulation 3.

- (3) In regulation 2 in the definition of ***licensing officer*** paragraph (b) delete “Part IVA of the *Road Traffic Act 1974*;” and insert:

the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008* Part 2;

5. Regulation 12 amended

In regulation 12(3) delete “2008” and insert:

6. Regulation 13A amended

In regulation 13A(1)(a) delete “Education Department of Western Australia” and insert:
