Spent Convictions Act 1988

Spent Convictions Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2010

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Spent Convictions Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2010*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Spent Convictions Regulations 1992*.

4. Regulation 6A inserted

After regulation 5 insert:

6A. Persons and laws prescribed for section 28(2)

For the purposes of section 28(2) of the Act —

- (a) each person mentioned in an item in the Table is prescribed in respect of the law mentioned in the item; and
- (b) each law mentioned in an item in the Table is prescribed.
