Police (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2005

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Police (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2005*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2005.

3. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Police (Fees) Regulations 1981**.

4. Regulation 3 amended

Regulation 3 is amended by deleting the full stop at the end of the definition of “accident” and inserting instead —

“**department**” means the department of the Public Service principally assisting the Minister in the administration of the Act;

“**road traffic conviction record**”, in respect of a person, means the record held in the department of the person’s convictions against the *Road Traffic Act 1974*;

“**traffic infringement notice record**”, in respect of a person, means the record held in the department of infringement notices served on the person under the *Road Traffic Act 1974* section 102.

”.

5. Schedule amended

The Schedule is amended as follows:

3. Photographs, authorised reproductions —
 - (a) 5 or more from the same film, per photograph \$9.50
 - (b) otherwise, per photograph \$16.00
4. National police certificates, each —
 - (a) for a volunteer \$10.00
 - (b) for an officer or employee in the Public Service \$34.00
 - (c) otherwise \$46.00

(b) in item 5 by deleting “\$64.50” and inserting instead —

- (c) in item 6 by deleting “\$15.60” and inserting instead —
“ \$16.00 ”;
- (d) in item 7(a) by deleting “\$27.50” and inserting
instead —
“ \$29.50 ”;
- (e) in item 7(b) by deleting “\$22.00” and inserting
instead —
“ \$29.50 ”;
- (f) in item 8 by deleting “\$27.00” and inserting instead —
“ \$29.50 ”;
- (g) after item 8 by inserting the following item —
