State Superannuation Act 2000

State Superannuation Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2003

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *State Superannuation Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2003*.

2. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *State Superannuation Regulations 2001**.

3. Regulation 244 amended

(1) Regulation 244(1) is amended as follows:

- (a) after paragraph (b) by deleting “or”;
- (b) after paragraph (c) by deleting the comma and inserting a semicolon and —

“

(d) a person who is not a Member but in respect of whom contributions have been made as if he or she was a Member; or

(e) a class of persons each of whom is a person referred to in paragraphs (a) to (d),

”.

(2) After regulation 244(1) the following subregulation is inserted —

“

(1a) In a direction in relation to a person referred to in subregulation (1)(d) the Treasurer must specify who is to be regarded as the Employer for the purposes of subregulation (2).

”.

- (3) After regulation 244(2) the following subregulation is inserted —

“

- (3) When giving a direction under subregulation (1) the Treasurer may make payment of the benefit subject to any conditions the Treasurer considers appropriate.

”.

4. Schedule 1 amended

Schedule 1 is amended as follows:

- (a) in Division 1 item 10, by deleting “of” and inserting instead —

“ **for** ”;

- (b) by deleting Division 2 item 69 and inserting instead —

“

69. **Zoological Parks Authority** established under the *Zoological Parks Authority Act 2001*

”.
