Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2002

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2002*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2002.

3. The regulations amended
