PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA John Sanderson, Governor. [L.S.]	}	By His Excellency Lieutenant General John Murray Sanderson, Companion of the Order of Australia, Governor of the State of Western Australia.
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I, the Governor, acting under section 13 of the *Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act 1909* and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, alter the boundaries of the South Dandalup Dam Catchment Area from those—

- (a) outlined  on plan WRC3281-01 held by the Water and Rivers Commission at its office at 3 Plain Street, East Perth; and
- (b) constituted and defined by proclamation published in *Gazette* 3 December 1982 at page 4676,

to those—

- (c) outlined  on plan WRC3281-01 held by the Water and Rivers Commission at its office at 3 Plain Street, East Perth; and
- (d) defined by straight lines connecting the Australian Map Grid coordinates (Australian Geodetic Datum 1984) for zone 50 specified on the annexure to the plan and extending along those coordinates in a clockwise direction from the first coordinate back to that coordinate,

each of which is represented for information purposes in the plan in Schedule 1.
