Road Traffic Act 1974

**Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment  
Regulations (No. 5) 2001**

Made by the deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 2001*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2001.

**3. The regulations amended**

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Road Traffic (Licensing) Regulations 1975\**.

**4. Regulation 21A amended**

Regulation 21A(1) is amended after the definition of “load capacity” by inserting the following definitions —

“

“**seniors’ card**” means a seniors’ card issued by the Office of Seniors’ Interests in this State;

“**seniors’ health card**” means a Commonwealth seniors’ health card, issued by the Department of Social Security of the Commonwealth;

”.

**5. Regulation 21P amended**

Regulation 21P(1)(b) is deleted and the following paragraph is inserted instead —

“

(b) is owned by a person who holds —

(i) a current pensioner concession card issued by the Department of Social

- Security, or the Department of Veteran's Affairs, of the Commonwealth; or
  - (ii) both a seniors' card and a seniors' health card.
- ”.
