**HOSPITALS (LICENSING AND CONDUCT OF PRIVATE HOSPITALS)
AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1997**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Hospitals (Licensing and Conduct of Private Hospitals) Amendment Regulations 1997*.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on the same day as the *Mental Health Act 1996* comes into operation.

Hospitals (Licensing and Conduct of Private Hospitals) Regulations 1987 amended

3. After regulation 4 of the *Hospitals (Licensing and Conduct of Private Hospitals) Regulations 1987** the following regulation is inserted —

“

Endorsement of licence to allow admission etc. under *Mental Health Act 1996*

4A. (1) An application to the Commissioner for a licence to be endorsed under section 26DA of the Act is to be made in a form approved by the Commissioner.

(2) An applicant for a licence to be endorsed under section 26DA of the Act shall cause a fee of \$100 to be paid to the Commissioner before the endorsement is made.

(3) The fee to be paid under subregulation (2) is in addition to any other fee payable in respect of a licence.

”
